


Introduction

- languages: Slovak, Russian, Croatian, Polish
- main motivation to create the project

Cooperation of young studying generation of Slavic nations:

- learning about national culture, history, customs, traditions
- searching for common signs and differences
- revealing possibilities of cooperation
- creation of the project:

"Slavic Youth Embassy"



Aim of the project:

- effort of globalization and versatility should take into account national individualities
- Slavic reciprocity
 - ✓ state sovereignty
 - √ diversity of cultures
 - √ tolerance
 - √ multiculturalism
 - √ cooperation





Primary task of the project:

- realisation of meetings of students of secondary schools in a form of a simulated conference of ambassadors of Slavic states
- search for possible cooperation in the area of:
 - economics
 - politics
 - education
 - social area
 - culture
 - sport





Secondary task of the project:

- require protocol form of communication
- maintain order of precedence
- teach accepting various ideas
- lead students to search for consensus
- formal dress code





Project is divided to three time periods

- 1.connecting and cooperating on a level of Slavic nations
- 2.expading cooperation to central and eastern regions of Europe
- 3.connecting and including east and west of Europe to one harmonious and productive prototype of prosperous Europe

1. Cooperation of Slavic nations



Connection and cooperation on a level of Slavic nations:

- ✓ addressing secondary schools in Slavic states
- ✓ creation of fictive "Slavic Embassies"
- ✓ meeting of representatives of schools –
 "delegates" to a conference "Slavic Youth
 Embassy"
- ✓ addressing embassies of Slavic states to a position of warranters of the project Slavic Youth Embassy

1. Cooperation of Slavic nations



Realisation of Slavic Youth Embassy

- ✓ areas of conference: economics, politics, education, social area, culture, sport
- ✓ school = delegacy = 1 ambassador + 6 delegates
- ✓ splitting to concrete areas of the conference and searching for possibilities of cooperation
- ✓ corresponding area is lead by a student in a position of a "delegate"
- ✓ used language: English

1. Cooperation of Slavic nations



Realisation of Slavic Youth Embassy

- ✓ ceremonial session of Slavic Youth Embassy
- ✓ final resolutions of cooperation will be protocolled and

submitted to particular embassies

✓ media publication



2. Expansion of cooperation to central and eastern regions of Europe

✓ including in the project countries of Central and Eastern Europe + non-Slavic countries
